

# REACH – Confirmation 1907/2006 EG

We hereby confirm that igus® GmbH, in pursuance with the EC Regulation 1907/2006 (REACH) dated 18. December 2006, acts as a downstream user (producer of products), and as such, we will fulfill all applicable requirements as specified in the REACH Regulation.

The suppliers of our raw material are obliged, in pursuance with REACH Article 33, to inform us immediately if the delivered raw materials contain a "substance of very high concern" in accordance with the REACH-VO ("SVHC substance") above 0.1 % by mass. Current status of the SVHC-list is 27.06.2024, 241 substances.

In the event that we receive information in this regard and thus become aware that the 0.1% weight by weight (w/w) for an SVHC substance has also been exceeded in our products, we will inform you immediately.

Based on the current state of knowledge (based on corresponding information from our suppliers), the specified SVHC substances > 0.1% can be contained in our products listed below:

In principle, under normal or reasonably foreseeable conditions of use, no substances on the current list of SVHC substances will be released from our products in accordance with REACH\_VO.
